



SUPPLIER ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

As a condition to doing business with ADC and or its affiliates (collectively "ADC"), Supplier agrees to comply with the Supplier Environmental Compliance Requirements set forth herein.

Supplier shall provide to ADC, within ten (10) days of ADC's request, detailed information as requested by ADC regarding the composition of and substances used in goods furnished by the Supplier to ADC. Such information shall be provided in either electronic or paper format as directed by ADC.

RoHS. Except as otherwise agreed between ADC and Supplier in writing, all products, components or materials supplied shall be in compliance with the European Union (EU) Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS) Directive 2002/95/EC and all subsequent amendments of RoHS.

REACH. Without limitation, Supplier shall disclose to ADC SVHC content and provide associated safe-use information, for articles, preparations, and substances provided to ADC; in accordance with requirements of the European Community Regulation 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical substances (REACH). Additional information regarding REACH may be obtained from the European Chemical Agency (ECHA), at the following URL <http://echa.europa.eu/>.

Suppliers shall disclose content of SVHC. When product supplied contains listed SVHC in amounts exceeding 0.1% weight by weight, the Supplier shall indicate the specific substance, the actual content (%w/w), and provide safe-use information for that substance, preparation or article, by way of material safety data sheets (MSDS) or equivalent documentation as determined by ADC. The list of SVHC may be periodically revised by ECHA, and Supplier shall provide product content & safe-use information based upon continually current REACH requirements and SVHC Listing.

Unless ADC waives a requirement(s) in writing for a specified timeframe or for specific product(s), Supplier represents and warrants that goods provided hereunder shall comply with all applicable environmental readiness laws, regulations, directives, codes of practice and/or standards, including but not limited to those described in this Section 26 and Directive 2002/96/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE). Suppliers shall defend, indemnify and hold ADC harmless from damages and claims related to Supplier's breach of the above representations and warranties and or failure to comply with the Supplier Environmental Compliance Requirements.
