



ADC Material Declaration Policy

ADC Telecommunications, Inc., has a long history of compliance with domestic and international environmental requirements wherever we have actively conducted business. ADC is actively reviewing its products for compliance to RoHS, and has developed a system to provide restricted substance disclosure reports for its products, which may depend on declarations from ADC suppliers, and/or other sources.

ADC currently provides IPC-1752 v1.1, material Declarations, using Declaration Class 1 with the 'Simplified' Declaration Type, as standard response to all material declaration requests.

ADC will provide IPC-1752-1 v1.1 Declaration Class 3 – JIG Level A and B information – upon request, subject to availability of the data from ADC suppliers, and/or other sources.

Material declaration for substances other than those included in EU RoHS and JIG-101 level A and level B is subject to negotiation.

All material declarations are made on a part number basis.
